The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) Program provides customers a credit toward their broadband service rates of up to \$50.00 if they meet eligibility requirements.

- (i) EBB is a federal benefit and willfully making false statements to obtain the benefit can result in fines, imprisonment, de-enrollment or being barred from the program;
- (ii) Only one EBB program benefit is available per household;
- (iii) The EBB Program is a temporary federal government subsidy that reduces my broadband internet access service bill and at the conclusion of the program, my household will be subject to the provider's undiscounted general rates, terms, and conditions if my household continues to subscribe to the service.
