

DO NOT CALL REGISTRY NOTICE

To address consumer concerns about unwelcome telemarketing calls, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and Federal Trade Commission (FTC) have established a national Do-Not-Call Registry. The registry applies to all telemarketers (with the exception of certain non-profit and political organizations) and covers both interstate and intrastate telemarketing calls. Commercial telemarketers are not allowed to call you if your number is listed on the registry.

Registration is free and your registered number will remain on the national Do-Not-Call Registry until you remove it. You may remove your name and number from the list at any time. The national registry prevents telephone solicitations made for commercial purposes only; be aware that the Do-Not-Call Registry will not prevent all unwanted calls. It does not cover the following:

- Calls from organizations with which you have established a business relationship;
- Calls for which you have given prior written consent;
- Calls which are not commercial or do not include unsolicited advertisements;
- Calls by or on behalf of tax-exempt non-profit organizations, for example for charitable or political purposes.

You may register your residential telephone number, including wireless numbers, with the national Do-Not-Call Registry:

By telephone: Call 1-888-382-1222 (TTY call 1-866-290-4236). The call must originate from the phone number you wish to register; or

Through the internet at www.donotcall.gov.

Your telephone number registration with the national Do-Not-Call Registry will be effective the next business day. Telemarketers have up to 31 days to get your phone number removed from their call lists.
